Welcome/Introductions

Ashley opened the meeting welcoming members, highlighting the purpose of the task force as a recommending group who will work collaboratively to create a 3-5 year plan for early learning in the Ferndale School District.

Each member introduced themselves, sharing their connection to Ferndale Schools and their reason for wanting to be a part of the early learning work of the district. Membership includes a range of expertise and passion in the field of early learning, as well as representation from classroom teachers, specialists, parents, administrators, and community members and partners.

Superintendent's Overview

Dr. Dominguez kicked off the task force by sharing some of her experience and expertise from her decades of local, state and national leadership in early learning. She talked about the importance of early learning from a child development lens and how investment in early learning results in enhanced student outcomes and graduation success. Dr. Dominguez shared that early learning spans prenatal to third grade, and that the National Center for P-3 has a

framework outlining the critical components for a school district for strong early learning programming.

Current Landscape

Ashley Hill gave an overview of the early learning landscape in Ferndale School District. She shared the current services for our youngest learners (see presentation slides for more details), highlighting:

- Developmental Preschool
- Jump Start Kindergarten (Transitional K or TK)
- Kindergarten – 3rd grade
