BOND UPDATE #83 10.30.20

I have a short report this week. Here's what's been going on since I wrote last:

- 1. The Design Team is in the final two weeks of producing the Permit Set of plans, which means the drawings are roughly 85% complete. The Permit Set will be submitted to the City of Ferndale as part of the application to receive our building permits.
- 2. Public and student safety remain top priorities for the entire Project Team. We have been working closely with Cornerstone to develop construction traffic routes that will minimize crossing paths with bus and school traffic. Whichever routes we ultimately choose, we will be putting in place additional safety measures, such as signage and flaggers, as well.
- 3. Last Tuesday (October 27), Riley Cornelsen, Bond Oversight Committee Co-Chair, presented the Committee's most recent quarterly report to the Ferndale School Board at their October business meeting. Riley's report is currently posted in BoardDocs and will soon be posted on the Oversight Committee's webpage as well.
