Overall thoughts on the video?

Key Takeaways:

- The adult takes 1/21 (if 20 students) of the space in the classroom
- Major transitions (like moving to specials, etc.) in early learning can disrupt the development of concentration
- Concern for the whole school buying in to putting the priority on youngest learners for space and schedules
- The need to inventory what our current spaces and environments look like and build consistency across the district

What questions do you have? (these will be addressed at future meeting for clarification)

- What are the state laws for napping for 3, 4, and 5-year olds?
- Concern about needing to get k students needing to be reading so they don't get behind.
- Questions re use of tables and on age/stage for expecting students to sit in desks/tables?
