If possible, please consider sharing the weekly reflection page (or any page) with your child's teacher by whatever method you have been communicating. The packets contain extra resources this first week, and are larger than normal. Please do not feel overwhelmed, and feel free to reach out to your child's teacher with any questions. We are here to help.

During this global pandemic, we feel strongly as a district that taking care of our families is the most important thing we can do. While organized by day of week, please do what works for your family's needs. Please do not let this work packet become a struggle or an issue.
