
## **BOND UPDATE #187**

Here's what is going on with our bond projects.

- 1. Our new Academic Wing is receiving some finishing touches, including final adjustments to building systems like lighting, heating, communications, security, and more. Now that school is back in session, most of this work is occurring in the evenings after students and staff have left for the day.
- 2. Hazardous materials are being removed in the north end of the old building this week. This area is being cleared first, so crews can start construction of the new CTE Wing, which will be located just south of the new Athletic Wing. Crews will begin dismantling the old FHS building on the afternoon of Wednesday, Jan. 18, after some safety briefings and an orientation of the area and existing utilities.
- 3. Crews are hard at work framing the concessions and restroom areas underneath the football field grandstands. Mechanical and electrical installation in that area will start soon, as well as the masonry that will form the exterior walls. Crews continue to pour concrete in the football field area, along with the weight room and new CTE Village areas.
- 4. Final touches are now underway on the CTE Village. These areas will be turned over for school use soon!
- 5. Framing work on the greenhouse has resumed in preparation for the new plexiglass panels, which are scheduled to arrive soon. It's very exciting to know this structure has now been recycled for the second time. Originally, the greenhouse structure was donated to the school, and now it has been reassembled in its third location.
- 6. Now that the school has turned over the old building footprint, utilities such as natural gas are being extended through those areas.
- 7. At the moment, final planning preparations are being made for the work that will occur in the Performing Arts Center later this year.
