Project overview:

A comprehensive facilities assessment in 2010 noted that many of Ferndale School District's schools need either renovation or replacement. The District has been listening to citizens and considering various scenarios to address the district's school facilities based on their feedback. In April 2017, the School Board decided to develop a bond package, primarily focused on renovating Ferndale High School to put before voters in November 2018. A Bond Task Force has been convened to provide community input into development of the total bond package.

Meeting objectives:

- Understand current conditions of the district's schools (e.g. aging facilities)
- Understand cost drivers for school facilities
- · Learn about funding for schools
- Develop Task Force overarching priorities for addressing facility needs

Key takeaways:

- Understanding of costs and funding associated with school facilities
- Understanding of the district's current facilities conditions
- Task Force prioritization of the district's current facilities challenges

Example community questions:

- How aware are you of the conditions and challenges with our school facilities?
- How important is it to you that the district address the challenges with school facilities?
- What facilities challenges do you think the district should be focusing on?
