Here's what is going on with our bond projects. Enjoy!

#### Kristi

1. Work on the FHS campus has continued to progress during the past week. Some of the highlights are outlined below:

#### Athletic Wing

- The wall paneling and sound absorbing panels have been completed and the gym is ready for bleacher installation next week.
- Wall pads have been installed.
- The wallboard is mostly hung in the Auxiliary Gym, and taping and finishing work is ongoing. Wall paint should get started there over the next week or so.
- Brick sealer application work continues on the exterior of the building.
- Plumbing lines are now being filled with water and tested. Fixtures are starting to come online in this area.
- Concrete floor grinding and polishing is coming along nicely.

#### Academic Wing & Commons

- Light fixtures are now being installed on the first floor. This is always a good indication that the area is getting close to completion!
- Welding of ductwork is underway in the culinary arts room and should be complete soon.
- Crews are making good progress on whiteboard and tackable wall installation.
- Mechanical and electrical wall trim out is ongoing and looking good.
- Interior doors and hardware installation is ongoing.

#### CTE Village



• The gold gym is now gone. The athletic building behind the gym should be removed over the next week or two.


#### Site Work

- Work on the underground storage detention system began this week on the north side of the new gym. This system is under the new bus loops and must be completed before work on the bus loops begin.


