

# BOND UPDATE #140

1.21.22

Here's what is going on with our bond projects:

1. The Bond Oversight Committee met on Tuesday for the first time this year. The committee received an update on bond-funded maintenance projects and also received a report on managing costs during a time of supply shortages.
2. Work on the FHS campus has continued to progress this week. Some of the highlights are outlined below:
  - a. The concrete elevated slab in the center section of the Academic Wing's third floor was poured last Saturday. The final pour at the west end will be early next week – which will mark the completion of the elevated slabs in the Academic Wing! The only remaining slab in that area is the floor of the mechanical mezzanine on the roof.
  - b. Concrete foundation work has begun this week for the new football field grandstands.
  - c. Welding, decking and detailing work is ongoing at the Academic Wing's east end and should wrap up over the next couple weeks.
  - d. The mechanical mezzanines in the Athletic Wing are receiving the necessary floor decking to prepare them to have concrete floor slabs over the next couple weeks.
  - e. Now that the weather has improved, the Athletic Wing's roof insulation panels can continue to prepare for the final metal roofing.
  - f. Interior framing work is ongoing and heading towards the east end of the Academic Wing. Meanwhile, exterior framing work on the building is making good progress – crews are about 70% complete.
  - g. Electricians, plumbers and ventilation crews continue to install items that will eventually be buried in the walls and ceilings of the new buildings. They're making good progress and heading towards the Academic Wing's east end.
  - h. The weather barrier is close to finished on the north side of the Academic Wing, and crews are now moving around to the south side to get started there.
  - i. Temporary roofing work continues on the Academic Wing, and more of the building is becoming dry. It won't be long now until keeping our crews warm and dry will be possible.
